

AN RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN, COLORADO CANCELING THE 2022
MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND DECLARING THE CANDIDATES ELECTED

RESOLUTION No. 3
Series 2022

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes § 31-10-306 state that write-in candidate affidavits must be filed no later than sixty-four (64) days before the election date; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes § 31-10-507 allows for an election to be cancelled under certain circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pitkin adopted Ordinance No. 1, Series 2020, which requires an affidavit of intent for write-in candidates as provided in Colorado Revised Statutes § 31-10-306, and further provides that, if the only matter before the voters is the election of persons to office and if, at the close of business on the sixty-fourth day before the election, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at such election, including candidates filing affidavits of intent, the clerk, if instructed by resolution of the governing body either before or after such date, shall cancel the election and by resolution declare the candidates elected; and

WHEREAS, the only matter before the voters at the 2022 Regular Municipal Election is the election of persons to office; and

WHEREAS, at the close of business on the 64th day prior to the 2022 Regular Municipal Election there were not more candidates than offices to be filled at such election, including candidates filing affidavits of intent;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN, COLORADO, THAT:

1. The Regular Municipal Election scheduled for Tuesday, April 5, 2022 is hereby canceled
2. All candidates are hereby declared elected and shall take office after April 5, 2022.
