RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO DELEGATE THE AUTHORITY TO THE TOWN CLERK TO APPOINT ELECTION JUDGES FOR REGULAR AND SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

RESOLUTION NO. 9 SERIES 2019

WHEREAS, the Town of Pitkin conducts Regular and Special Elections and such elections require the appointment of Election Judges; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Municipal Election Code specifies how such appointments are to be made in §31-10-401 C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, the timing and process of making appointments may be cumbersome in the context of the timing of the regular Board of Trustee meetings; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees desires to delegate this authority to the Clerk in the interest of efficiency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado, that;

- 1. The Town Clerk is hereby delegated authority to appoint Election Judges for the Special Municipal Election scheduled for November 19th 2019.
- 2. The minimum number of judges will be sufficient to meeting statutory requirements and also to fulfill the needs of Town of Pitkin elections.
- 3. The Town Clerk is also authorized to determine appropriate compensation for the Election Judges based on statutory requirements and best practices among municipalities.
