- Building Inspector –Tom Gibb A setback variance was approved by the Zoning board of adjustment and a permit was approved for a Stage and Bar, plus attached storage for 329 Main Street (Bon Ton Hotel) on the downstream side of the Hotel. A setback variance was approved by the Zoning board of adjustment and The Pitkin Board of Trustees, for a 0' setback to drip line on one corner of the New Home design for Cory and Stephanie Nasso at 312 eleventh street. A building permit has been approved.
- Zoning Board Ed Pianalto The Zoning Board conducted the January Meeting on January 13th, 2025. All board members were present to discuss a Zoning Change Request for 601 State Street (Pitkin Train Depot). After hearing from Jake Schellenberg, the new Pitkin Train Depot owner, Zoning Board Members and public input, the Zoning Board, with a vote of 4-0, is recommending to the Board of Trustees that the Board approve the Zoning Change Request to include the property from 6th and State Streets to 9th and State Streets on the 'mountain side' of State Street from Residential Zoning to Business Zoning. In addition, the Zoning Board continued to finalize the updating of the 2022 Zoning Code.
- Environmental Health Gayla Gibb No new systems presented. No repairs. No activity. In the event that Pitkin chooses to follow the County's lead requiring inspections only on Transfer of Title, the dynamic will change on the EHA job. It will leave only new installations and repairs as the major responsibility of this job. As we have only a few of those each year, I would consider staying on as EHA.
