- Building Inspector –Tom Gibb (Interim) – One residential permit was approved

- Streets – Jesse James Garetson – State Street ditches and culverts are cleaned out from 9th Street to the top of town limits. The intersection of River and 9th Street has been repaired and a load of ¾” road base spread.
Gunnison Valley Excavation has proposed to do Pitkin snow removal that Gunnison County does not accommodate at the same rate as 2021-2022 for the snow year 2022-2023. They are scheduled with a mini-excavator with a 12” bucket for May 23,2022. There is an estimate of 6 to 7 blocks that needs mechanical clean out and the culvert at 1st and Quartz Lane replaced at a rate of \$140/hour. Hopefully the ditches will be running by June 1st.
- Ditches – Vacant – No report
- Cemetery – No report until May or June 2022
- Town Hall – Garry Winget – The State Historical Fund grant request has been submitted and accepted by them. The awards will be announced sometime in June. The project total is \$35,766. The grant request is \$26,824. The maximum cash match listed in the application is \$8,942, but is reduced by \$1,141 if we do not use the contingency or grant administration items. The cash match comes out of the Town Hall budget item.
