- Streets – Jesse James Garetson – Street Commissioner has been very busy assisting with cleaning ditches and culverts.
State Street and 9th Street to the top of Town are complete as of Monday 6/7/21. On 9th I built a crown from soil and gravel removed from the ditches and culverts. Mast Trucking spread 2” of ¾” road base from the United Gravel pit from 9th to the top of Town (4 loads total). On State, 3.5 blocks to 5th Street, ditch soil that was prepared last year mixed with 3 loads of ¾” road base and used to create a crown and drainage. The 4th load was spread on 6/8/21 by Mast Trucking to complete that section of State.
- Ditches – Vacant – Ditches are on. The Town requests that each property owner manage the ditch adjacent to their property by removing debris.
- Cemetery - The Cemetery Board will be having its first meeting of the year soon, likely around the 16th of June. No exact date has been selected. Those interested should watch website or bulletin boards . Once a date and time are selected an announcement will be posted. Two years ago there was plan announced for a “Remembrance Monument.” Last year, for various reasons, there was no progress on this project. But, it is now well under way. Sub-assemblies for the monument are being shop fabricated and by the time Council meeting takes place approximately 90% of the parts will be in town. The rest will be here by the end of June and the actual final assembly/install on Cemetery grounds should happen in mid-July.
- Town Hall – Garry Winget – A representative from the State Historical Fund will be in Pitkin to meet with me in mid July, the date is not yet set.
- Parks and Rec – Sara Lamar – Park benches are out and Sara will complete the playground inspection next week.
