

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN, COLORADO VACATING A PORTION OF SEVENTH STREET

ORDINANCE No. 3
Series 2020

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes § 43-2-301 et. seq. allows for vacation of public roadways; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado is desirous of vacating a portion of certain public way; and

WHEREAS, the said portion of public way which would be vacated would not operate so as to leave any land adjoining said way without an established road connecting said land with an established public road;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN, COLORADO, THAT:

1. Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the “Fred and Alicia Archuleta Street Vacation Ordinance, Series 2020.”
2. Portion of Public Right-of-Way Vacated. There is and shall be vacated hereby a portion of a certain right-of-way heretofore reserved for public use in the Town of Pitkin, Colorado, which portion so vacated more particularly is described as follows:

That portion of 7th Street lying between and adjacent to Lot sixteen (16) of Block eighteen (18) and Lot one (1) of Block twenty-seven (27) in the Town of Pitkin, Colorado.

3. Consideration. For and in consideration of the sum of \$21,500.00, the Town of Pitkin hereby vacates the portion of the certain right-of-way described in Paragraph 2 of this Ordinance.
