

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN BOARD OF TRUSTEES CANCELLING A
SPECIAL ELECTION AND DECLARING THE CANDIDATES ELECTED

RESOLUTION NO. 4
SERIES 2021

WHEREAS, the Town of Pitkin scheduled a Special Election on April 6, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the election is to be conducted in accordance with the Colorado Municipal Election Code; and

WHEREAS, the only matter before the electors at the election is the election of one seat to the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. 31-10-507, the Town of Pitkin adopted Ordinance 2020-1, which provides that if the only matter before the voters in a Town municipal election is the elections of persons to office and if, at the close of business on the sixty-fourth day before the election, there are no more candidates than offices to be filled at such election, including candidates filing affidavits of intent, the Clerk, if instructed by resolution of the governing body either before or after such date, shall cancel the election and declare the candidates elected; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. 31-10-306, the Town of Pitkin adopted Ordinance 2020-1, which requires that affidavits of intent of write-in candidates be filed prior to sixty-four days before the day of election, which for the April 6, 2021 special election is February 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, as of the date of this Resolution there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at the April 6, 2021 Special Election and no write-in affidavits have been filed; and

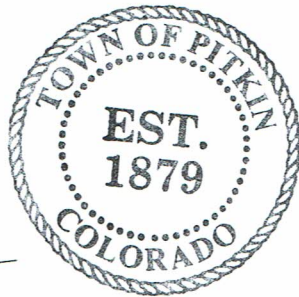
WHEREAS, pursuant to its authority under Town of Pitkin Ordinance 2020-1 the Board of Trustees desires to instruct the Town Clerk to cancel the April 6, 2021 Special Election and declare the candidates elected;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado, that;

1. Pursuant to Town of Pitkin Ordinance 2020-1 the Board of Trustees does hereby instruct the Town Clerk to cancel the April 6, 2021 Special Election and declares Ramon Reed elected to the Office of Trustee for the remainder of the current two-year term, to commence upon being sworn into office at the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees on February 8, 2021 and to end on April 5th, 2022.

2. The Board of Trustees does hereby further instruct the Town Clerk to publish such notice of the canceled election as required by law.
