

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO USE A PORTION
OF 9th STREET AS A TEMPORARY PARK

RESOLUTION NO. 7
SERIES 2021

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-23-107, the Town of Pitkin holds its streets in trust for the use of the public; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pitkin desires to use a portion of 9th Street from State Street to Quartz Creek for temporary park purposes; and

WHEREAS the portion of 9th Street desired to be used for temporary park purposes is currently not used as a right-of-way; and

WHEREAS the Town of Pitkin has no present or future plans to use the portion of 9th Street desired to be used for temporary park purposes as a right-of-way;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado, that;

1. The portion of 9th Street from State Street to Quartz Creek shall be used as a temporary park for public use (the “9th Street Temporary Park”); and
2. The 9th Street Temporary Park shall consist of no more than one (1) gazebo and ~~one (1)~~ four (4) picnic tables; and
3. The Town of Pitkin will retain its title to the 9th Street Temporary Park; and
4. If it is determined by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Pitkin that the 9th Street Temporary Park is needed as a right-of-way, the Board of Trustees may pass a resolution revoking the 9th Street Temporary Park, and the portion of 9th Street from State Street to Quartz creek will be reverted to a public use as a “Roadway,” as defined in C.R.S. § 43-2-301(3).
