

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN, COLORADO, REGULATING PARKING  
WITHIN THE TOWN OF PITKIN

ORDINANCE NO. 2  
Series 2022

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes (C.R.S.) 31-15-101, et seq., authorizes a municipality to enact regulations that promote the health, safety, and welfare, and improve order, comfort, and convenience of the municipality and inhabitants thereof; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S., et seq., authorizes a municipality to ADOPT A PARKING CODE?? ;

WHEREAS, the Town of Pitkin, Colorado

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado has found that such regulations promote the health, safety, morals, and the general welfare of the community as stated herein; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN, COLORADO THAT:

1. The Town of Pitkin, adopts this Parking Code to regulate parking within the Town of Pitkin, Colorado.
2. Visiting trailers shall only be parked on the public right-of-way of streets that are 80 (eighty) feet wide. These streets are: Main Street, State Street, River Street.
3. Property Owners may park on all public streets except for lanes. Lanes are: Aspen Lane, Quartz Lane, Sage Lane.
4. All vehicles and trailers parked on public streets must be operable and have current registration.
5. Violators of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado Parking Code shall be informed via certified mail with return receipt and allowed 15 days from the date of receipt to remedy illegal parking. If the parking violation is not resolved within the allotted time, the offending vehicle will be towed at the owner's expense.
