AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN, COLORADO, APPROVING A COMPENSATION SCHEDULE FOR THE BUILDING INSPECTOR

ORDINANCE NO. 1 Series 2023

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes (C.R.S.) 31-4-109 provides that officers and employees of a Town shall receive such compensation as the Board of Trustees may fix from time to time; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. 31-4-109 provides that compensation for officers and employees shall be set by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, upon careful review of the current compensation schedule, the assigned duties and responsibilities of the building inspector, and also upon careful consideration of the importance to the safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado of retaining a qualified and competent building inspector, it was decided that a modification of the compensation schedule for the building inspector was in order; and

WHEREAS, upon careful consideration and review of the duties and responsibilities required of the building inspector, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado decided upon an appropriate compensation schedule which is set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN, COLORADO THAT THE TOWN OF PITKIN, COLORADO THAT THE FOLLOWING COMPENSATION SCHEDULE FOR THE BUILDING INSPECTOR OF THE TOWN OF PIKIN, COLORADO SHALL BE APPROVED AND ADOPTED:

- 1. For the duties and responsibilities associated with residential, business, and other permits, the Building Inspector of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado shall receive sixty-five percent (65%) of the total permit fee.
- 2. The adoption of this ordinance hereby repeals Town of Pitkin, Colorado Ordinance No. 2, Series 2001.
