AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN, COLORADO APPROVING A COMPENSATION SCHEDULE FOR THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN, COLORADO

ORDINANCE No. 4 Series 2024

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes, Section 31-4-109 provides that the Mayor of a Town shall receive such compensation as the Board of Trustees may fix as early as the last meeting before a regular election; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes, Section 31-4-109 provides that the compensation of a governing body, including the Mayor, shall not be increased or diminished during the term for which they have been elected or appointed; and

WHEREAS, the next regularly scheduled municipal election for the Town of Pitkin, Colorado was scheduled for the 2nd day of April, 2024 prior to its cancelation; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration and review of the current compensation schedule, duties, responsibilities, and time commitment of the Mayor of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado, the importance of having a committed, qualified and competent Mayor and with consideration of the Town's current revenue and budget it was decided by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado, that a modification to the compensation schedule was in order;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN, COLORADO, THAT:

- 1. Ordinance 1 Series 2006 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- 2. For the duties and responsibilities associated with the position, the Mayor of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado shall receive \$ per month.
- 3. This compensation schedule shall become effective after the date of the regularly scheduled municipal election, which shall be the 2nd day of April, 2024, and shall begin the month the duly elected Mayor for the Town of Pitkin, Colorado, has been sworn in for the next term of office.
